SOURCE: On 02/15/2016, I (Officer Tomlins #735) was working uniformed patrol. At approximately 1409 hours, I met with victim and his mother, in the PVEPD lobby, in reference to a 242 PC- Battery report.

M.O.: Possible known suspects engage in an argument with the victim and his mother related to their illegally stopped vehicle. During the argument, one suspect pushes victim then both suspects flee.

VICTIM'S/WITNESS (JUVENILE'S MOTHER) STATEMENTS: I contacted the victim, and his mother, and they stated the following: On today's date, just prior to contacting PVEPD, was waiting for to pick him up in the 600 block of Paseo Del Mar. was traveling northbound on Paseo Del Mar and when she arrived at location, she crossed the double solid center lines and stopped her vehicle on the west side of the roadway. stated that she did this because there is no parking permitted on the east side of the roadway and she did not want to cross the street with the limited visibility caused by the curve in the roadway.

While was loading his surfboard into the vehicle, a female pedestrian looked toward and stated something to the effect of, "You know this is really unsafe and illegal the way you parked your car here." stated that she said sorry and told the female that she would be leaving soon. The female was accompanied by a male that was carrying an infant in a back carrier. The male and female continued making comments about s illegally parked vehicle and indicated that they live nearby. told the two to contact the police if they were that concerned. The male then produced a video camera and began filming and

told the male that he could not film him because he was a minor. The male then approached and said, "I can do whatever I want." related that the male's face was so close to his, that he was using the brim of his hat to repeatedly poke in the forehead. The male then said something to the effect of, "I would beat you up if I didn't have this baby" and told to hit him. The male then raised his hands and pushed just above his waist. related that the push did not hurt or injure him but the force did cause him to move backwards approximately one foot.

The male and female then departed the location southbound on foot. lost sight of them near Paseo Del Mar and believed they may have entered that property via the pedestrian gate. and stated they were desirous of prosecution.

The two were described by and as:
-White male, late 30's, 5'09", skinny/ fit, with short or no hair. Wearing a tan baseball style hat, peach shirt, tan shorts, and an infant in a back carrier.
-White female, 30's, 5'05", skinny, with dark blonde hair. Wearing a blue shirt and possibly jeans.

OFFICER'S STATEMENT: Based on the incident, along with the location, the

description of the involved parties, and their actions, I believed that the male and female were likely [redacted] and [redacted]. [redacted] and [redacted] reside at [redacted] and have contacted the Police Department numerous times regarding illegally parked vehicles in the 600 block of Paseo Del Mar.

Detective Sgt. Hellinga #727 was called in and created a 6-pack photo line-up including [redacted] photograph. While separated from his mother, I had read the PVEPD Photo Line-up Admonishment and asked if he understood the admonishment and he said he did. [redacted] related that more than one of the photographs looked like the male and then identified a photograph that was not [redacted]. Then, while separated from [redacted] I had [redacted] read the PVEPD Photo Line-up Admonishment and asked if she understood the admonishment and she said he did. [redacted] quickly identified [redacted] as the male in the above incident.

Sgt. Hellinga then created a 6-pack photo line-up including [redacted] photograph. While separated from his mother, I had [redacted] read the PVEPD Photo Line-up Admonishment and asked if he understood the admonishment and he said he did. [redacted] was unable to make an identification. Then while separated from [redacted] I had [redacted] read the PVEPD Photo Line-up Admonishment and asked if she understood the admonishment and she said he did. [redacted] then identified a photograph that was not of [redacted] See attached/ signed PVEPD Photo Line-up Admonitions and DOJ Cal-Photo Image Line-ups.

EVIDENCE: I took a photo of [redacted] and booked the flash disk into property locker #26 (See attached).
