Investigation Narrative

On 12/20/15. at approximately 0933 hrs, I, Service Officer Castro, received a call from [redacted] at [redacted]. She advised that she lived next door to [redacted] Paseo Del Mar and for the last several weeks the dog at that location had been barking. I advised [redacted] that another resident had already called and that a dog barking noticed had been left. I asked [redacted] if the dog was still barking and she stated it was not. After speaking with her for several minutes, regarding [redacted] she advised me that she would call back if the dog started barking again.

At approximately 1026 hrs [redacted] called to thank us. Officer Sean Tomlins #735 had called him and advised a dog barking notice had been left. [redacted] advised that he had received a call from his neighbor stating that she had been woken up by the dog barking and would call the police department. [redacted] wanted to inquire whether or not another neighbor had called. I advised him someone else had called and they were seeking information in regards to barking dogs and not a call for service. [redacted] asked if the call was documented and I advised him that it was not. Calls are documented when the resident requests documentation. [redacted] appeared to be upset by my answer. I advised him I would called the neighbor back and get clarification. [redacted] asked for me to wait five minutes because he wanted to call first.

At approximately 1034 hrs, I contacted [redacted] and her husband [redacted] via telephone and was advised they wanted the incident documented and an officer to be sent out (reference incident 175931).
